- “Graduates unavailable for employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

- “Graduates employed in the field” means graduates who are gainfully employed in a single position for which the institution represents the program prepares its graduates within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program. - period of employment must begin within six months of the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- “Placement Rate Employed in the Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- Number of Students Taking Exam is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the published program length and who took the exam in the reported calendar year for the first time.
- Exam Date is the date for the first available exam after the students completed the program.
- Passage Rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- Number Who Passed First Exam Taken is the number of students who took and passed the licensing exam in the reported calendar year on the first attempt.
- Salary is as reported by the student or employer.
- “No Salary information Reported”. Is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.
